Advanced Media Workflow Association (AMWA) members desire to make software contributions to the AMWA, and the AMWA Board would like to accept these contributions. The following rules have been established to ensure a consistent process exists for accepting these contributions, and to describe the licensing framework within which contributions and potential subsequent distributions by the AMWA are made.

- 1. Members agree that all inbound code contributions to the AMWA shall be made under the Apache License, Version 2.0.
- 2. All contributions shall be accompanied by a Corporate Contribution License Agreement or an Individual Contribution License Agreement, as appropriate unless the work is contributed under an existing AMWA project.
- 3. If a contribution is being made under an existing AMWA project, the contribution shall be accompanied by the contribution form found in the appendix of the AMWA IPR policy (available at https://www.amwa.tv/policies).
- 4. All outbound code that is distributed by the AMWA will be made available under the Apache License, v2.0.
- 5. All written documentation will be contributed to, and made available by AMWA under the CC-BY-ND 4.0 International License.
- 6. Any document made available by the AMWA in relation to any code contributions will include the following copyright notice "Copyright(c) Advanced Media Workflow Association, Inc. [year] under the CC-BY-ND 4.0 International License" or some similar notice. The distribution may contain a NOTICE section listing contributions to the distribution per the Apache 2.0 License.
